We raised \$8000. On October 4, 2008 riders in many different states and venues met and raised \$10,000. Join up with us today and help us reach past any goals we now have imaginable.

The idea had been on the mind of Skiatook trail rider Debbie Briggs' for quite some time, but when her sister was diagnosed with breast cancer, the wheels began rolling to implement the program. With the help of fellow trail riders the rides were scheduled and held with great success. Each ride involved some differences due to location and local participation. Some participants rode for "honorees" of the event, most of which include the riders' friends and relatives affected by breast cancer. Several riders were breast cancer survivors. The riders were encouraged to wear and tack up with as much pink as possible. What a site it was to see. Not only the women, but the men and horses were not shy about wearing Pink.
